A subcommittee was formed to write a draft charter for the full committee to review at a future meeting.

Proposal to develop a Community Cyber Preparedness Program (Joe)

Joe Bongiorno & Jose' DeSousa proposed a Community Cyber Preparedness Program based on trainings they received from the TEEEX program at Texas A&M and funded by DHS/FEMA at the Massachusetts Department of Fire Services. Their trainings provided communities with strategies and processes to increase their cyber resilience. The topics included how to analyze cyber threats, how to build a process for developing a cyber preparedness program in their communities, the importance and challenges of sharing information about cyber threats and attacks and finding low to no-cost resources to improve cyber resilience.
