SHED – Cut-off-Date: May 17 Commission Meeting – To get all estimates and back-up for September Town Meeting. Wayne and/or Peter will contact Reimer and Bronstein (Bob Buckley) to ask them to approach a Burlington developer like Nordblom Company to manage the project and construct the shed. We are waiting for the Blueprints. The present site is non-conforming and will need Planning Board approval. Money will be approved for work on the West School and Museum.
