DEP TERMINATES BOIL WATER ORDER FOR BURLINGTON

BURLINGTON - DPW Director John Sanchez reports that the boil water order has been lifted and residents may resume normal water usage.

Following 37 confirmatory tests of samples taken throughout town, Burlington DPW and the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection determined there is no E. coli present in the water system.

“We are confident that the town’s water is safe and we thank the community for their patience while we worked to address these concerns,” Sanchez said.

The DPW is continuing to work closely with DEP, but residents no longer need to boil water before drinking or cooking.

Residents should run their faucets for 10 minutes to clear out any built up water in their pipes and should dispose of ice and make ice twice using their refrigerator’s ice maker before using the ice.

Residents should also remove and replace water filters.
