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## SPECIAL CONDITIONS

All testing shall meet the Massachusetts Drinking Water Regulations 310 CMR 22.00 in addition to the following specifications:

The Contractor (testing laboratory) must hold a license certificate from the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection for those parameters for which a bid is being submitted, Certificate of Approval No. \_\_\_\_\_.

Lab Results are to be in a written form acceptable to the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection and reported, in writing, simultaneously to both that agency and the Water Treatment Manager, Town of Burlington DPW, 25 Center St., Burlington, MA 01803. Additionally, Lab Results are to be uploaded to EDEP.

The Contractor shall include the cost of one pickup per week at 171 Middlesex Turnpike, Burlington, MA 01803 - typically every Tuesday. Additional pickups may be required.

The Contractor shall provide sample bottles, chain of custody and analysis reports, and compliance reporting to MA DEP.

The bid price for each parameter shall include all charges. No additional mark ups such as fuel surcharges, disposal/waste fees, trip blanks, etc. are allowed. The number of samples is subject to change. The amount of samples is an estimate.

Samples will be done on a schedule as determined by the Treatment Plant Manager.

**The length of this contract is from when the agreement is signed through June 30, 2023. The Town reserves the option to renew for two additional one-year periods at the sole discretion of the Town of Burlington.**
